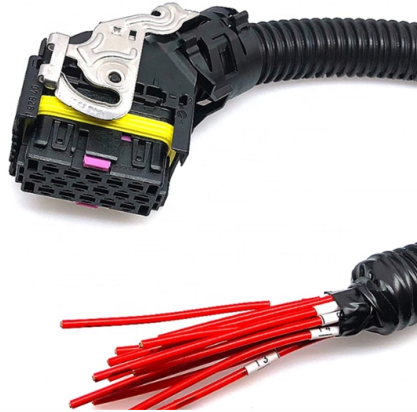

The standard voltage is 220V, with a frequency of 50Hz, compatible with most modern electronic devices.
