

Bedroom electrical distribution box installation height



Overview

The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. This height also safeguards the box from potential. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.
