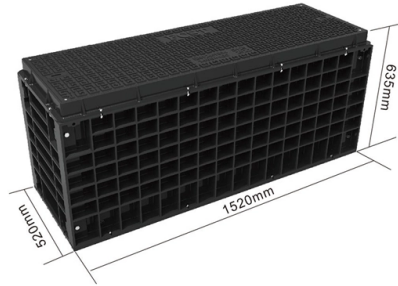


Can power cords be run through low-voltage cable trays



Overview

Due to their exposure to the open air because of the cable trays, the wires contained within need a very durable outer covering. The regulations dictate that the cables must either be Type TC (also known as Tray Rated) or must be metal-armored (Type MC). Question 8: Can high voltage cables be installed in cable trays?

Answer: Yes — NEC permits type MC (Article 334) and type MV (Article 326) in industrial establishments where qualified persons will service the installation. Multiconductor cables rated over 600 volts shall be separated from lower. Low voltage wiring refers to insulated wire with non-metallic sheathing that transmits 50 volts or less of electricity. Standard power outlets in the United States and Canada carry 120V, and most lighting fixtures, electronics, and devices draw up to 120V.
