Optical fusion splicer joins two optical fibers by melting end faces using an electric arc, creating a permanent bond with minimal signal loss. As explained in industry resources, this technique achieves insertion losses as low as 0.01 dB and minimizes back reflection—critical for maintaining. Fusion splicing is used for joining cables during network installation projects, repairing cables, mounting pre-polished splice-on connectors, and many applications in factories that make fiber optic components and subsystems.
